Scientific name: *Erythranthe guttata* (*Mimulus guttatus* - prev.)

Common name(s): Yellow Monkey Flower

Name as shown in Phylogenies: E. guttata

Ploidy: Diploid

Description:

Erythranthe guttata, known as Yellow Monkey Flower, is a representative member of the *Mimulus* genus, which includes over 150 species; *E. guttata* is endemic to Northern California.

Due to their extensive variation in floral morphology, pollinators, growth habit and ecological niche, *Mimulus* have been extensively used in the study of evolutionary biology and ecological systems.
